Dear Mr. Blythe:

My Oklahoma City office has forwarded your request for information on the Creek claim which is before the Indian Claims Commission.

This claim is identified as Docket 21. The Commission had approved an award, thus clearing the way for a request for an appropriation of funds to pay it.

However, the decision was appealed by the intervenors, then a cross appeal was entered by the Government, and late on the afternoon of March 14, the Creeks also entered a cross appeal.

Under the circumstances, a request for funds at this time is not appropriate, and it is now indefinite as to when final action may be expected.
