We understand consideration is being given the Honorable E. B. Maytubby for appointment as Governor of the Chickasaw Nation.

Mr. Maytubby has a distinguished record as an Indian leader and has taken a prominent role in tribal affairs. He has been active in the Inter-tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes, and in the National Congress of American Indians. The son of a full-blood Chickasaw, he has been elected six times as County Treasurer of Muskogee County, the last two times without opposition. He is a life-long Democrat and an outstanding American in every sense of the word.

We are pleased to place on record our conviction that he is well qualified in every way for the appointment under consideration.
