Thank you for your recent letter enclosing a copy of the Resolution adopted on November 30, 1963, by the Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma requesting that a bill be introduced in Congress which would grant your tribe the authority to sell certain real property located in Ottawa County, Oklahoma. I can appreciate your desire to have this legislation enacted this session, since you have a buyer who is interested in the property.

I shall be happy to introduce such a bill in the Senate. I will get in touch with the Bureau of Indian Affairs here in Washington and start working on a draft bill.
