Dear Senator Monroney:

This is to advise that The Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes in regular session on October 9, 1963 at the Eufaula Indian Boarding School, Eufaula, Oklahoma, voted unanimously to go on record expressing deepest appreciation for the good fortune of having assigned to the Muskogee Area Office as Area Director, Mr. Virgil Harrington, a man of understanding and sincere interest in the welfare of the Indian people.

This Council pledged full support and assistance in every way in accomplishing with the Area Director and his staff the best administration the Five Civilized Tribes has ever had. The Council further expressed appreciation for the fact that the Muskogee Area Office is taking the Government down to the people, working with them at the community level in a coordinated effort designed to raise the social and economic standards of the Indians of the area.

Area Director Harrington was not in attendance at this October meeting.
