Dear Mr. Hyden:

Mrs. Constance Burnett, 1630 Northwest 13th Street, Oklahoma City, formerly Constance Daniels and the daughter of George Daniels, an Osage Indian deceased since February, 1961, made inquiry of this office this morning relative to the settlement of the estate of her father.

From information given to us over the telephone, it seems that there is some type of contract entered into between her stepmother and herself which is involved in the estate. I am further advised that she has checked at the Pawhuska Agency and was told that the matter was in Washington for handling.

I would appreciate it if, with this sketchy information, you can check into this matter and advise me at your earliest convenience of the status and if there is anything that Mrs. Burnett can do to be of assistance in securing final disposal of this case.
