
You will recall that I telephoned you some 60 days ago regarding a deposit of Indian Service funds with this bank. You were kind enough to take this matter up with the Treasury Department and with Virgil Harrington, our local Area Director of Indian affairs.

I am thankful to report to you that as a result of your efforts on my behalf, we have today received the deposit of \$150,000.00 from the Muskogee area office.

The construction of new physical properties at the Sequoyah High School by the Bureau of Indian Affairs is proceeding very well. One group of buildings is nearing completion, and I understand the total program will involve some 3 to 3½ million dollars. We are hoping there isn't too much delay after the completion of the first building until the next group is started.
