Dear Mr. James:

I have your letter of December 8, in connection with the proposed sale of the Choctaw-Chickasaw segregated coal lands, stating that you have already voted on this matter.

It will probably be some time before you receive the payment, as Congress will have to appropriate the money with which to meet these payments. As I understand it, the payment will be around \$300 to each enrolled member. If you want detailed information regarding the sale of these lands, I suggest that you write to Mr. W. O. Roberts, Superintendent of the Five Civilized Tribes Agency, Muskogee, Oklahoma, as they are handling this matter.
