Sanitation Facilities Projects: for 1968 plans

P.L. 86-121 San. Facilities

1. Pontotoc County - \$75,000 is estimated to construct approximately 50 scattered homes for Chickasaw Indian homes or other Indian families that reside within the county. The Chickasaw Executive Committee has sponsored home surveys and will be the sponsoring organization to work with the PHS in the project. The sanitation facilities include individual wells, electric pumps, inside bath facilities, septic tanks, garbage disposal, and necessary connections.
2. The Public Health Service, in cooperation with the Choctaw Tribe of Oklahoma is requesting \$75,000 for a P. L. 86-121 project in the Hanobia Community of the Choctaw Nation in Oklahoma. The Hanobia Community is situated in the southwestern part of LeFlore County and the Northeastern part of Pushmataha County. Approximately 50 homes will be included in the project. The project is administered from the Oklahoma City Indian Health, with Dr. B. E. McBrayer in charge.
