Mr. BRYSON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce

A BILL

To require the establishment of a classification of freight and a scale of class rates, for application to transportation of property by railroad, so adjusted as not to discriminate among regions or territories in the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 1 of part I of the Interstate Commerce Act, as
4 amended, is amended by inserting after paragraph (2)
5 thereof a new paragraph as follows:

6 “(2a) It is hereby declared that the establishment of
7 a classification of freight and a scale of class rates to apply
8 to the transportation of property by common carriers by
9 railroad subject to this part, so adjusted as not to discriminate

1 among regions or territories in the United States, is necessary
 2 in the public interest; and it shall be the duty of the
 3 Commission to administer and apply the provisions of this
 4 part so as to give full effect to the declaration contained in
 5 this paragraph.”
