Dear Friends:

I am sending to your adjutant under separate cover a copy of the Congressional Record of Tuesday, July 30, 1946. You will note on pages A4885, A4895 and A4902 where I inserted, with my own comments and remarks, resolutions adopted by Tulsa Post 577, Veterans of Foreign Wars, General Clarence L. Tinker Chapter 160, The Military Order of the Purple Heart at Tulsa and by the Joe Carson Post No. 1, American Legion of Tulsa.

Each of these resolutions bear on veterans housing and insist upon the designation of surplus military installations for dismantling and the use of the estimated 1,500,000,000 board feet of lumber and other essential materials that can be made available from these projects for the use of veterans homes.

It occurred to me that these resolutions were so appropriate and timely that I took this method of bringing them to the attention of my colleagues in Congress and to the attention of the War Assets Administration, with the hope that possibly some good might be accomplished and that eventually these materials would be channeled to veteran housing projects with priority for such purposes. The program of veteran housing has bogged down under the interminable and ever increasing red tape or bureaucracy. There is so much material available in these surplus installations that I have insisted that these installations be dismantled and the material be channeled and earmarked immediately for use in constructing homes for the veterans.

I might suggest that my insertion of these resolutions with my comments in the Congressional Record has already aroused the interest of the War Assets Administration. They promptly called me by telephone and asked for a personal interview to discuss the subject, and I verily believe my use of the resolutions in this manner will result in some benefits for the veteran. At least I am hopeful for this end.
