Dear Mr. Schwabe:

Perhaps you can give me some authentic information in regard to the Federal Housing that was built for the Oklahoma Ordnance Works at Pryor, Oklahoma. As you recall, these houses were prefabricated and were constructed so that the employes at the Dupont operated powder plant could have homes in which to live during the war emergency. Now that the plant at Pryor has been declared surplus property and soon to be sold I am wondering what disposition will be made of these five hundred homes?

My understanding is that they will be sold soon and can be torn down and moved to other communities. Several members of my family are in the market for a home and we would like to purchase several of these homes and have them moved to our respective communities, either in Tulsa or Bartlesville.

Can you tell me who to get in touch with concerning the sale of this property? I have been unable to find anyone at Pryor or at the RFC office here in Tulsa who can give me any authentic information. It is my thought that if possible, these homes should be divided and sold to prospective home-owners in this locality.

I continue to note the good work that you are doing as our representative in Washington. Only this morning, I noticed an article appearing in the Tulsa World which quoted you as saying, "Now is the time to pay up your debts rather than acquire new ones." This is good, sound policy and I wish we could get over this idea to other representatives in the nation's capital.

I will appreciate your giving me a prompt reply to the above mentioned matter.
