Dear Judge:

I am pleased to acknowledge receipt of your letter of June 27, in which among other things you request a copy of the validating statute just passed by Congress and signed by the President. A copy of this act is being printed as a Public Law and will be ready for distribution before long. I have ordered a considerable quantity of this bill reprinted in order that I may make distribution to the lawyers and judges of my Congressional district. It will be several days before the reprints are in my hands and ready for distribution. As soon as they reach me, I intend to mail them and if you do not receive your copy within the next two or three weeks, please write me again and I'll see that you get a copy. I consider this a very important piece of legislation and I spent a great deal of time attempting to safeguard it in all respects so far as I could anticipate possibilities of a proper or improper application of the provisions of the bill to a given state of facts.

Judge Thomas of Miami was one of the callers at my office this morning. I inquired of your health and that of Mrs. Coppedge. I hope she is continuing to improve and that you are enjoying the best of good health.
