Mr. Schwabe of Oklahoma introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Indian Affairs

## A BILL

Authorizing an appropriation for payment to the Osage Tribe of Indians on account of their lands sold by the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That there is hereby authorized to be appropriated the sum
- 4 of \$776,742.03, being the net amount received by the United
- 5 States from the sale of land of the Osage Tribe of Indians in
- 6 the State of Kansas under article I of the treaty of September
- 7 29, 1865 (14 Stat. L. 687), credited to the civilization fund
- 8 on the books of the Treasury of the United States and used
- 9 for the benefit of Indian tribes other than the Osage Tribe,
- 10 now residing in the State of Oklahoma, as found by the Court
- 11 of Claims in its opinion of May 28, 1928 (66 Ct. Cl. 64),

- 1 in a case known as B-38 entitled "Osage Nation of Indians
- 2 against the United States" instituted under the Act of Feb-
- 3 ruary 6, 1921 (41 Stat. L. 1097).
- 4 SEC. 2. That the said amount when appropriated shall be
- 5 placed in the Treasury of the United States to the credit of
- 6 the Osage Tribe of Indians and be distributed in accordance
- 7 with the rules and regulations governing payment of moneys
- 8 accruing to members of the Osage Tribe of Indians.
- 9 Sec. 3. That said appropriation shall be in full, com-
- 10 plete, and final settlement of the claims of the Osage Tribe
- of Indians against the United States under said treaty of
- 12 1865 above cited; and the said tribe of Indians waives all
- 13 claims to interest on account of delayed payment and the
- 14 United States waives all claims which might be asserted as
- 15 offsets.
- 16 SEC. 4. That the Secretary of the Interior is hereby
- 17 authorized and directed to pay, out of said appropriation when
- 18 made, the fees and expenses of the attorneys of record, in
- 19 accordance with the provisions and percentages in their con-
- 20 tract as approved by the Secretary of the Interior May 5,
- 21 1931.
