Your recent request for a copy of the Stigler Act "that was approved in 1945" has arrived in the absence of Congressman Schwabe who is in Tulsa for a few days to attend the wedding of his only daughter.

However, I have talked with Congressman Stigler himself about the matter, and he suggested that I send you a copy of Public Law 116, which is enclosed, as he says it is the only bill of his which was approved in 1945.

However, he also said that he had an amendment in the Annual Interior Department Appropriation Bill of 1944 which may be what you want. This is now known as Public Law 369, and I am requesting a copy from our Documents Clerk, and shall forward the same to you as soon as it is received.
