## A BILL

Authorizing an appropriation for payment to the Osage Tribe of Indians on account of their lands sold by the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That there is hereby authorized to be appropriated the  
4 sum of \$776,742.03, being the net amount received by the  
5 United States from the sale of land of the Osage Tribe  
6 of Indians in the State of Kansas under article I, of the treaty  
7 of September 29, 1865 (14 Stat. L. 687), credited to the  
8 "Civilization Fund" on the books of the Treasury of the  
9 United States and used for the benefit of Indian tribes  
10 other than the Osage, said Osage Tribe of Indians referred  
11 to herein now residing in the State of Oklahoma, as found



1 by the Court of Claims in its opinion of May 28, 1928  
 2 (66 Ct. Cl. 64), in a case known as B-38 entitled "Osage  
 3 Nation of Indians against United States of America" insti-  
 4 tuted under Act of February 6, 1921 (41 Stat. L. 1097).

5 SEC. 2. Said amount, when appropriated, shall be  
 6 placed in the Treasury of the United States to the credit  
 7 of the Osage Tribe of Indians and distributed in accordance  
 8 with the rules and regulations governing payment of moneys  
 9 accruing to members of the Osage Tribe of Indians.

10 SEC. 3. Said appropriation shall be in full, complete,  
 11 and final settlement of the claim of the Osage Tribe of  
 12 Indians against the United States arising under the treaty  
 13 of 1865, above cited.

14 SEC. 4. The Secretary of the Interior is hereby  
 15 authorized and directed to pay, out of said appropriation  
 16 when made, the fees and expenses of the attorneys of  
 17 record, in accordance with provisions and percentages in  
 18 their contract as approved by the Secretary of the Interior  
 19 May 5, 1931.
