A BILL

Relating to the investments of Osage Indians of Oklahoma

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the*
2 *United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Secretary*
of the Interior may, upon the request of any member of the Osage
tribe, invest any or all of the funds of such member in a life
annuity insurance policy, which upon his or her death will go
to the heirs of Indian blood of such member; or may, upon the
request of any member of the tribe, use the funds of such member
to buy a life annuity insurance policy for any member, of Indian
blood, such insurance policies to be held in trust by the United
States and not subject to sale, cancelation, or transfer of
any kind without the consent of the Secretary of the Interior
during the life of such members and his or her heirs, the annuities
coming from such life-insurance policies shall be paid to the
persons designated therein. Such policies and the income there-
from shall not be subject to attachment, garnishment, or execution
and may not be pledged as security for any indebtedness; and it
shall be stated in such policies that they are held in trust
for such Indians.
