Dear Mr Disney.

We the Pawnees, hope that you have not forgotten to introduce the two bills in Congress Our tribal Councils discussed with you this summer.

1st A bill to allow \$200000 now on deposit in the U. S Treasury to the credit of the Pawnee tribe, to be used by the said Pawnee tribe to finance a delegation to Washington D. C. and for other expenses necessary to prepare their claims against the U. S. Government

2nd - A bill to permit the Pawnee tribe to present their claims (against the U. S. Government) to the court of claims for adjudication.

You have some of the necessary information in your files. if there is any further information you care to have, relative to the subject matter, We will do our best to supply it.
