

Congressional Bill.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

That jurisdiction be, and the same hereby is, conferred upon the Court of Claims to hear and determine, and to give judgement against the United States for, any claim whatever, in law or equity, of the Pawnee tribe of Indians of Oklahoma, against the United States of America, founded upon any law of Congress or upon any treaty or agreement between the said tribe of Indians and the United States, provided that the said tribe of Indians shall file a petition in the Court of Claims under this act within one year from

the date of approval there-of.
