I am very much opposed to the plan to have Government
"Fact Finding Boards" (H.R. 4908)

I believe a much better solution to the problem would
be an amendment to the Wagner Act, making it a two way
proposition - requiring Union contractual responsibility
as well as on the part of the employer and imposing an unfair
labor practices penalty upon both interests instead of the
present inequitable requirement that it can only be imposed
against the employer.
