DEAR CONGRESSMAN:

WITH REFERENCE TO THE "GOVERNMENT
FACT FINDING BOARD, H.R. 4908" IT APPEARS
TO ME THE ONLY THING TO DO IS TO AMEND THE
WAGNER ACT BY MAKING IT A TWO-WAY STREET SO
THERE WILL BE EQUAL RESPONSIBILITY TO THE
EMPLOYER AND EMPLOYEE THIS WAY WOULD RE-
ESTABLISH BETTER WORKING RELATIONS.

THE DANGER OF THE BILL H.R. 4908
IS THAT IT DOES NOT PROPOSE ANY SANCTIONS
AGAINST CONTESTING PARTIES AND WOULD WEAKEN
THE PRINCIPLES OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING -
DESTROY SMALL INDUSTRY WITH LESS OPERATING
RESERVES THAN THE BIGGER COMPETITIVE CONCERNS -
DEVELOP INSURMOUNTABLE COMPETITIVE SITUATIONS,
PARTICULARLY AT THE EXPENSE OF SMALL BUSINESS.

I TRUST YOU WILL GIVE EVERY CONSIDERA-
TION TO THIS BILL BEARING IN MIND THE FACTS AS
I HAVE THEM OUTLINED.
