Dear Mr. Newport:

Your telegram of January 10th addressed to the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation, has arrived in the absence of Congressman Schwabe, who has not yet returned to Washington from his trip over the District. However, I anticipate his return next week, and shall immediately bring your message to his attention.

You may be assured that Congressman Schwabe will appreciate your interest in wiring, and will be grateful to have the benefit of your views on the present labor situation. He has been making tremendous efforts to obtain the views of his constituency, both by mail and by personal interview. Early in December he mailed out forty thousand questionnaires addressed to the rural and local boxholders at every post office in the District, and during the latter half of December he personally visited every post office and county seat in the ten counties of the District, to give the people an opportunity to express their views personally to him. Despite all this effort, there are, of course, many who neither received a questionnaire nor conferred with him personally. Hundreds like yourself are wiring and writing their opinions on the problems of the day, and you may be sure that Congressman Schwabe will keep your views in mind when considering proposed legislation on these various matters.
