Your wire of yesterday urging me to oppose May's conscription bill was received by me after I had already declared myself against this bill. You have doubtless observed by the morning papers that I voted against the bill.

Great pressure was brought to bear upon us to vote for the bill, but I couldn't conscientiously do so and am confident that I voted for the best interests of organized labor and for the laboring man generally.

I cannot believe that the bill is truly American in spirit.
