Dear Congressmen:

The writer presumes that it is not necessary to urge you to lend your support to constructive legislation and corrective legislation to bring about stability out of this terrible confusion which exists due to politics being played in Washington in this so serious time.

We feel that you, as an elected official representing our state and our nation, owe it to yourself and to your constituents to bring about a definite and final conclusion to such overt acts as have been committed by ruthless labor leaders in their effort to destroy our country during this reconversion period.

It appears that only a silly school boy could not understand that there is more business in this country today than there ever has existed, due, to the dire need of every citizen for things which they believe they want and which they have been deprived of during the five years of war. Such things as are needed must be supplied and that no difficulty of unemployment could or would ever have occurred if strikes had been entirely eliminated from the thinking of the American people.

We believe that it is high time that you, as a representative, not only of your state and your town but your country in general must realize that we are being misled, in fact, led away from a solution of our problem.

We trust that you and all your constituents will vote to forever condemn and brand a traitor a man who could ruthlessly destroy our nation such as has been the case of John L. Lewis and others of his ilk.

Laws enacted to prevent such recurrence of these things are absolutely necessary at this time and we hope that you, as a citizen and
