**SCHWABE SOUNDS
WARNING ON LOAN**

Opposition to U. S. Money Aid for
Britain 'Almost Universal,'
Oklahoman Tells Congress

WASHINGTON, March 12 (AP)—
Opposition to the proposed United
States loan to Great Britain is
"almost universal," Representative
Schwabe (R., Okla.), told congress.
"The GI's are opposed to it, the
veterans are opposed to it and the
citizens generally express their op-
position," the Oklahoman said in a
statement in the record.

"We should heed the advice and
wishes of our citizens on this sub-
ject before authorizing the appropri-
ation."

In a second statement for the
record, Schwabe said that "the
propaganda that is being put out"
about why reconversion is being re-
tarded is "not deceiving veterans."

"They know," he said, "that re-
strictions, regimentation and bu-
reaucracy is responsible and that
this administration will be held
responsible unless many of the
bureaus are abolished and recon-
version allowed to proceed in the
normal way."
