Dear Miss Robinette:

I have your postal card of March 9th asking me to support the loan to Great Britain.

I have made a very thorough canvass of the voters of my District by sending out forty thousand questionnaires regardless of political affiliation, and the results show that about ten to one they are against this loan. The sentiment all over the country seems to be against it. Under these circumstances, I cannot favor the proposal, since I must represent the wishes of my constituents.

I thought you would appreciate my being frank with you as to my attitude, and also having the information as to present prevailing opinions from over the country.
