Dear Leo:

I received your wire a few days ago relative to the Palestine situation. From what I can find out about conditions there they are most appalling. I have never been able to appreciate the British position. I have made inquiries, but I don't get much inside information from the State Department here on such critical issues.

You may rest assured that whether it is applied to Russia, Great Britain or any other country, I am opposed to censorship of the news. That is the reason that I am opposed to bestowing our bounty, taxing the people to pay for contributions to UNRRA and to make the British loan, or give the money to Great Britain. I have voted consistently against giving or lending our money to countries where we are not allowed to know what is being done with our money and our commodities. I shall remain steadfast in this position.
